PRESIDENT'S PEN:

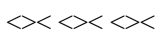

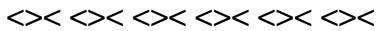

Dignity Gospel Quartet



In mid-2004 a group of employees at a Houston funeral home were persuaded to share their love of gospel music with willing audiences in and around the greater Houston area as a part of the community outreach efforts of their employer. Little did they know that the Lord would bless their efforts with more

opportunities than imagined as they practiced and prayed for His guidance. Today that group is known as The Dignity Gospel Quartet, a ministry of the non-profit DGQ Ministries, and their popularity has extended well beyond the geographic boundaries of the gulf coast region.

In addition to the quartets many appearances at both public and private venues and recording projects each year they serve as the host artists for what has become known as The Greater Houston Area Gospel Songfest©. This series of concerts features nationally acclaimed gospel music artists in concert three times each year, most often in the spring, mid-summer, and fall. In addition to the performance of Dignity Gospel Quartet at each of these events, the audiences experience two more award-winning well known gospel artists or groups. The "Songfest" concerts have steadily grown in popularity and attendance. For the first time in 2015, DGQ Ministries has established a special group, The Artists Circle comprised of some of the quartet's most faithful supporters. Members of this group enjoy season passes to the entire concert series along with other benefits including private receptions with visiting artists prior to the concerts, reserved seating, merchandise discounts and a personal invitation to a private dinner and concert honoring DGQ Ministry sponsors and Artists Circle Members each year. Membership in The Artists Circle is limited to 100 members annually. According to quartet manager Russell Allen, a few 2015 memberships remain available until December 31, 2014.

The quartet is comprised of Clint Hebert, tenor; Wally Shuttlesworth, baritone; Stan Rule, lead; and Russell Allen, bass. Their bookings are managed by Jackie Snider, the founder of the original group. The quartet is proud of their membership in the Southern Gospel Music Association and Bay Area Gospel Music Association and they are thankful to their God for the blessings and opportunities He continues to provide.

The school had a Model T bus. One day the bus driver did not show up and I said I'd drive the bus myself. We got going, got everyone home, don't remember much after that, but that's all that matters. In 1942 I served in World War 2 till it ended. After the service, I traveled to Natchitoches, Louisiana, attended Northwestern State to be a machinist for two years. After school me, my wife and child went to Oak Grove, Louisiana, picked a bail of cotton, received \$90.00 and moved to Houston, TX. I joined the Houston Fire Department in 1950. I was a fire inspector for hospitals for 7 years but a member for 21 years. I then retired April 1972. I went to BAGMA right after it was organized. Frank and Mildred Deal were members of the church I attended. I videoed mostly all the singings, until they had someone else interested in shooting video. I missed a couple due to having a hard time driving at night. Mildred would come pick me up and carry me back home. Now I'm 93 and I cannot do it anymore.
