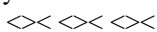

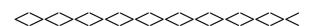

My heart is overflowing with thankfulness as I write this article for the BAGMA Trumpet. God is faithful, and Howard and I want to be a testimony to that truth! July is birthday month for both of us. He will celebrate his 89th birthday, and I will admit to turning 87. God is indeed faithful, and we trust Him to give us wisdom in how we spend this season of our lives. We are not able to travel like we once did, and we are always thankful when there is an opportunity to be with those who share our passion for gospel music. We loved seeing so many precious friends at the BAGMA 25th Anniversary Celebration!!! Our longtime colleagues JC and Nelda Johnson picked us up, brought us to this wonderful event, and made an unforgettable drive in the rain to get us home. Ray Walker, President, conducted an excellent program of honors and recognition of service. Sally Currey, and others, organized a great time for everybody. We loved seeing a multitude of treasured friends. I won't list names because I might leave somebody out. Please know that your hugs and handshakes were just what Howard and I needed. The Christian Comedian Brent Reed was fun. He sat at our table, and we chatted about the artists in the gospel

music world we both know and have worked with. I am reminded that Southern Gospel music is a strong force across the nation. I thank God for the huge number of people who share our passion for this "God-centered" music and the message of hope it brings. A recent example of this was the induction of two great friends from my past—Mark Lowry and Candy Hemphill Christmas— into the Nashville Gospel Music Hall Of Fame. Candy also received the GMA "Honors Award" for the "Bridge Ministry" an organization she founded to feed the homeless in Nashville. The list of presenters that included Bill Gaither, Mike Huckabee, Amy Grant, Steve Green, and Reba McEntire, is an indication of the influence of our music. Watching the telecast of the induction of Mark Lowry by Bill Gaither brought back memories of the personal thrill of having Bill preside over my induction into the GMA Hall Of Fame in 2005. Oh yes--my life has been blessed!! An exciting portion of my years in Nashville involved both Mark Lowry and Candy Hemphill Christmas. I signed a 14-year-old Mark Lowry to a contract with my booking agency. Much later, his tenure with the Gaither Vocal Band created a "forever" niche in gospel music. His induction into the GMA Hall Of Fame is highly deserved, and I am honored to have been a part of the journey. We are indeed delighted for the induction of Candy Christmas. I was booking the Hemphills when Candy was a teenager singing with her family, and she was a regular guest on my early TV shows. This recent recognition by the GMA of her "Bridge Ministry" left no doubt that her deepest desire is to serve God in helping others. I will forever be thankful for the blessing of working with the Hemphills, the Gaithers, and a multitude of gospel artists, in those years in Nashville. When Howard and I moved back to Texas, Bill Gaither invited me to be one of the Homecoming Friends on the Gaither videos. This experience has convinced me of the power of our beloved music to change lives. My purpose for writing this article is to keep "shining a light" on Southern Gospel and to encourage our wonderful BAGMA artists and the faithful members. May God bless you

as you continue to spread the good news of the gospel.

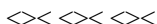

Many of you may know this, but when I was born, my parents named me Valonda Kay. Since I was 2 days old, I've been tagged with "Tootsie". Those were wonderful days that I will always cherish. During our singing together, we recorded 8 albums. I still enjoy listening to those and reminiscing about our childhood. In the 1980's, we were members of and I served on the Board of Directors for the SWGMA Association

for many years. I met many lifelong friends and fellow ministers during those years. I have been a member of BAGMA for many years and have served on the Board of Directors for the past 6 plus years. I once again have met many lifelong friends and gotten reacquainted with many friends from the "good ole days". You can NEVER have too many friends.

In 2009, God allowed me to record my 1st solo project. It is called "God Is Faithful" because I cannot remember a time when HE was not there for me when I need Him. In 2013, God allowed me to record another CD entitled "CHRIST is CHRISTmas". So many have lost the true meaning of Christmas, so I pray these songs will remind everyone of the "Reason for the Season". I loved working on both of these projects and hope that the message of Christ shines through. What a marvelous truth is in those songs.

I am always excited and happy when invited to sing for a service, concert, revival or anytime that God's people get together.
